 Re: School Cancellation/One and Two-Hour Delays

There are times during the school year when weather can create unsafe conditions for transporting students to school. The Ohio Revised Code allows for a school district to close for calamity, emergency or hazardous weather. School closings in excess of the minimum hours required by law to be open for instruction, will be made up at the discretion of the Board of Education.

One-Hour/Two-Hour Delays

The Sebring Local School District is instituting a one-hour/two-hour delay program. This procedure may be utilized when it is determined that weather or road conditions will not jeopardize the safety and well being of the students and staff. A one-hour or two-hour delay will be announced around 6:00 a.m. If the conditions do not improve, school cancellation could be announced by 7:30 a.m.

The one-hour or two-hour delay means that the regular starting time for each individual school will be delayed for one or two hours. **If we are on a one-hour delay, regular transportation will be provided but delayed one hour. If we are on a two-hour delay, regular transportation will be provided but delayed two hours.** Lunches will be served in all buildings but there will be no breakfast program at B.L. Miller and the high school.
