Tremco Presentation: Zach Tieche and Kevin Butler assessed our roofing needs via inspection and infrared scans which provide scientific data. They presented their findings on the roofing work that needs to be completed in the District using ESSER funds. They also have preventative maintenance plans. Tremco is currently paying for the education of several of our former students.

Board of Education discussion on masks: Mrs. Jones asked Mrs. Viscounte how our cases have been. Mrs. Viscounte reported that December has had the most cases so far. We have ten cases with five being new today. We have to cancel games and practices for the next ten days. This is our first breakthrough case, and the first time we had to cancel athletic activities. Our next meeting is Jan 10. The board will revisit masks at that point..

Discussion on athletic program: Mr. Clark stated that we have 22 applicants and a few recently to be about 25 total applicants for football coach. In mid November, we had 9 to 10 returning students interested in playing football. We did an in-school survey where 13 students signed up including two females. A few of the students struggle with eligibility. We were hoping a town hall meeting would bring more students out for football. If we didn't have football, it wouldn't

affect our league standing right now. We could possibly play 8 man football, but it would be a statewide schedule.

Comments from the public: Matt Seidel says soccer was tried in 2001 and it failed. He stated that we need to address why we are losing students to other schools when we have the opportunity for playing time. He says that we haven't put any money into strengthening and conditioning, and that the weight room needs to be expanded. He also believes we would invest in our facilities to draw kids in.

Another audience member thought maybe wrestling would be a better option than soccer. Another person stated that his son didn't feel intimidated here due to the smaller size. Bigger schools can be intimidating.

Kyle Billingsley asked if we looked into facebook and/or youtube advertising. He thought maybe that could be a project for the kids.

The Board decided to start a committee with Mrs. Vecchio and Mrs. Green as members.
